Registry office and credit card payments

This registry office accepts cash and debit for all purchases.

This registry also participates in a third party credit card processing option where you as a consumer, can elect the option to pay for products and services via credit card if you choose to do so. This third party credit card processor is called OptionPay.

OptionPay is a consumer facing brand that empowers consumers by allowing them to pay for registry services by credit card, if they prefer to exercise that option. OptionPay in turn pays the registry directly for these services. OptionPay charges a user fee of 2.99% to the cardholder for all major credit card transactions. The cardholder receives immediate credit towards their purchases, may earn points where applicable and peace of mind knowing that the transaction for the products and services they have purchased, has now been completed.

OptionPay is an opt-in payment service. At any time the consumer may choose to pay for their purchase through any of the traditional payment options currently available at this registry.
